The Burns Cemetery is a prairie cemetery located 1 mile south of Burns Wyoming on South Main Street (formally State Highway 213). The purchases of cemetery plots are not limited to residents of the town of Burns and there are no religious designations.

Cemetery plots are available for purchase:

Single space	\$ 50.00
Block of 4	\$200.00

Opening and Closing of grave site: (no vaults are required) Opening and closing of site must be done by Town of Burns.

Casket	\$300.00
Urn	\$ 75.00

A map of the Burns Cemetery can be viewed at the Burns Town Hall at 327 S Main Street.

Planting

Planting of trees or shrubs at individual cemetery plots is not allowed.

Headstone/footstone requirements:

The Burns Cemetery contains both headstones and footstones. (Be sure to discuss this with your monument company).

Headstone and grave markers are limited to not more than 48 inches wide and 30 inches high. Benches and other structures must also meet these requirements.
